If you are interested in actively pursuing meeting the educational qualifications to become a primary caregiver in a two or three star family child care home there are several options listed below. You can review the information and decide which option is best for you!

PDL Level 3

Oklahoma Competency Certificate in Early Care and Education for Master Teacher: Complete 1,050 hours of child care training. It is offered at some technology centers. This certificate does not expire. Candidate must pass the Master Teacher competency exam. Contact your local Career Technology Center to find out about this option.

PDL Level 4

CDA Credential:

Complete 120 clock hours of child care training plus other requirements. To find out about requirements go to www.cdacouncil.org. This national credential must be renewed every three years. The Scholars program provides assessment scholarships to eligible students.

CCP Credential:
