- 1. Go to <u>www.okregistry.org</u> to find the Statewide Training Calendar.
- 2. On the left side of the screen, there are different ways to filter training.

a. If you are on a smart phone, look for this filter symbol and click on it.



- 3. Under Filter Training, the second dropdown will say Certificate of Achievement and Stipend.
- 4. Click the down arrow under Certificate of Achievement and Stipend and select the Certificate of Achievement you want to view approved training for. <u>You must select one.</u>
