I will provide a support system to both families and personnel and maintain high standards for being positive role models, high motivation, unity, morale, dignity, and worth of each individual among co-workers and the center. I will encourage self-worth, choice making, exploration, imagination, emotional, and cognitive development in each child. At the very least I will provide a center that meets and maintains Department of Human Services (DHS) and Stars regulations--a center parents, families, personnel, and the community will call their own.
